A registration fee for student, faculty and staff cars used on the Edwardsville campus was approved Friday, Sept. 19, by the University's Board of Trustees.

Authorization for the fee is included in a policy resolution which the board adopted governing vehicular traffic on campus. The resolution requires that parking decals be displayed on all student, faculty and staff automobiles.

Under terms of the resolution, a parking and traffic committee will be appointed by Chancellor Rendleman to supervise parking and traffic regulations, establish parking fees and recommend disciplinary procedures for violators. Members of the committee will be named from persons recommended by the Student Senate, the Faculty Sub-Council and the Non-Academic Employees Council. At least one third of the members will be students.

The trustees' resolution authorizes the administration to adopt vehicle registration and parking fees of not less than \$5 per year and not more than \$20 per year to help defray the cost of registration, enforcement of regulations and operation of parking facilities.

Registered vehicles can be parked in specially designated parking lots reserved for scudents, faculty or staff. Metered or manned pay parking lots will be available for public use.

The establishment of the State Junior College in East St. Louis has resulted in several significant changes for STU. Dr. Jefferson Ware has accepted assignment with the State Community College of East St. Louis from September 1,1969, through August 31, 1970. Cynthia Thomas, Coordinator of Student Affairs, located in the Deulah Building, is available to assist in regard to questions concerning STU efforts in East St. Louis. Her phone number is 184-406. Mrs. Lila Teer and Mr. Schaefer of Area and International Services, located on the fifth floor of the Spivey Building, are available to assist in general STU matters in the downtown area.
