The disaster alert siren system will be tested at 11:25 a.m. and 7:25 p.m. on Tuesday, March 30, and Wednesday, March 31, 1971.

The alarms are sounded at the beginning of each quarter to orient campus personnel to the sound of the sirens.

To avoid confusion or misunderstanding, $\underline{a11}$ instructors are asked to annouce the time of the test at the beginning of classes on March 30 and 31, 1971.

Eighty tornadoes have occurred in the first 70 days of 1971 resulting in 116 deaths.

Preparedness is the key to saving lives. The tests are made for this purpose.
