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

SUBJECT: President's Annual Speech

I would urge each of you to be in attendance for the President's speech to the University community, Thursday, September 29, at 4 p.m. in the Communications Building Theater.

It is the President's intent that this address become an annual fall tradition. There are two basic purposes:

- to provide an update on developments that affect the University, outlining both on-campus and off-campus activities and concerns; and
- to suggest directions for the future.

For those of you unable to sit in the theater, the speech will be televised live to several on-campus locations by the closed circuit transmitting facilities of the University Broadcasting Service.
