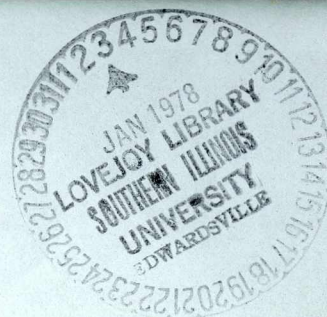

SUBJECT: Presidential Scholars Task Force

This program will provide monetary grants from Foundation funds to those exceptional students with high academic potential who are designated Presidential Scholars.

The Task Force has the following charge:

1. Recommending criteria for the selection of Presidential Scholars;
2. Recommending procedures for implementing the criteria in the selection of Presidential Scholars; and,
3. Recommending directions for programmatic development of the Presidential Scholars program.

The Task Force will report its recommendations on or before February 1, 1978.
