SUBJECT: Emergency Red Cross Blood Drive

On March 30 we received a letter from Mrs. Roanne Rutman of the Missouri/Illinois Regional Red Cross Blood Services notifying us of a serious deficit in scheduled blood collections for the week of August 6, 1979. Mrs. Rutman states in her letter that "...this potentially dangerous situation could be turned around if SIU-E would agree to sponsor a faculty - staff - student bloodmobile on Monday and Tuesday, August 6 and 7 for 200 donors each day..."

Mrs. Rutman has been informed that the University will be pleased to help in this emergency situation. Accordingly, the Red Cross Blood-mobile will make an emergency visit to the campus on Monday and Tuesday, August 6 and 7, 1979. The blood donation station will be set up in the St. Clair Room (the east half of the Meridian Ballroom) from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on those two days.

A sign-up table to register as a donor will be available in the Goshen Lounge-North Gallery Wall on Monday, July 30; Tuesday, July 31; Thursday, August 2; and Friday, August 3 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day. Telephone registration is also available by calling campus extension 2794.

I hope that you will give this matter serious consideration and trust that our response will meet or exceed the goal of 200 units of blood each day.
