

SUBJECT: Appointment of Director of Personnel Services

It is with great pleasure that I announce the appointment of Dr. Earl Beard as Director of Personnel Services.

Dr. Beard, who has been acting vice president and provost since September 19, 1979, will assume his new responsibilities July 15. The appointment is subject to ratification by the Chancellor and the Board of Trustees.

As administrator of the centralized office of personnel services, Dr. Beard will have responsibility for: Faculty Personnel Services, Civil Service Personnel Services, Professional Staff Personnel Services, "Other" Personnel Services, Labor Negotiations, Personnel Records Management, Development Programs for Faculty and Staff, and Personnel Relations.

The University community is well acquainted with Dr. Beard, who joined the faculty as a professor of history and Dean of the School of Social Sciences in 1967. He was named Special Assistant to the Vice President and Provost in July, 1977, and he accepted the position of Assistant Vice President for Academic Personnel Administration in September, 1978.

With the five principal organizational units of the institution in place, we can give full attention to our responsibilities in achieving the educational and public service mission of the University.
