The 25th anniversary of the opening of the Edwardsville campus will be celebrated during special ceremonies, Wednesday, October 10, in the Meridian Ballroom of the University Center, beginning at 10:30 a.m.

Guest speakers will include: A. D. VanMeter Jr., Chairman of the SIU Board of Trustees; Lawrence Pettit, Chancellor of SIU; John Ades, representing faculty appointed before 1966; and Lynn Ward, representing alumni.

For the first time, Presidential Awards of Merit will be presented, "in recognition of sustained and extraordinary commitment to furthering the mission and values of Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville."
