SUBJECT: Flood Relief Efforts

Due to the disastrous flooding in the St. Louis metropolitan area, there is an immediate need for relief assistance. The American Red Cross, Salvation Army, and other local organizations are calling for volunteers to assist with a variety of relief efforts. Assistance is needed with sandbagging, supply transportation, water distribution, mobile food center staffing, damage assessment, and clean-up.

Opportunities to assist with this effort are being coordinated through the Information and Volunteer Center located on the first floor of the University Center. Volunteers should contact the Center at 692-2686 for specific volunteer opportunities or agency phone numbers.

A flood relief collection drive is being conducted through September 7, 1993, by Office of Student Affairs. Canned goods and clothing items are being collected at the following locations: Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs, Alestle, Tower Lake Commons, Rape and Sexual Abuse Care Center, Early Childhood Center, University Center North Entrance, Kimmel Leadership Center, East St. Louis Center General Services Office, School of Dental Medicine student lounges in the administration building and the clinic, and the Student Fitness Center Lounge.

Given the previous commitment this University has shown to the St. Louis region, I am certain that you will again come through in this crucial time of need.
