Music Facilities Grand Opening

A ceremony celebrating the Grand Opening of the Music Facilities Consolidation in the Communications Building will be held Thursday, September 14, at noon, following the Board of Trustees meeting. Guests may park in the Visitors Lot or in Lot E, west of the Communications Building.

The \$4.8-million project consolidates classrooms, studios, practice rooms and faculty offices for the Department of Music, formerly dispersed throughout the campus. It resulted in a two-floor addition on the south side of the Communications Building, providing more than 13,200 square feet of usable space. The project also included renovation of existing space for the Information Technology unit and renovation of the existing stage and auditorium in the University Theater.

The new addition was occupied the first week of August, about one semester earlier than originally planned. Congratulations to everyone who kept ahead of schedule!
