SUBJECT: Federal Drug Free Work Place Act

As an institution with numerous federal contracts and grants, Southern Illinois University at Edwardsville is bound by the provisions of the Federal Drug Free Work Place Act. We are committed to a strong drug free awareness program within the University community. As part of the University's goal to maintain a drug free environment, employees must notify immediate supervisors within five days of any criminal drug statute conviction occurring in the workplace.

This includes illegal drug usage, manufacture, possession, or dispensation while on University property. The University must impose a sanction or require violators to participate in a drug abuse assistance program.
