Associate Circuit Court Judge A. Andreas Matoesian granted a continuance until 9 a.m. today on the University's application for a temporary injunction to end the strike by union painters and the slow-down by operating engineers.

Yesterday, operating engineers who normally operate the heating and refrigeration plant were asked to leave the University after they declined to operate the plant at an acceptable capacity. The University is attempting to operate the plant now with supervisory personnel.

Should the University be granted its application for an injunction today, it will still take a minimum of 12 hours to restore building temperatures to near normal levels.

The University regrets the discomfort and inconvenience caused by the strike and appreciates the cooperation of faculty, staff and students during this difficult period.
