Lionel K. Walford, chairman of the department of physics, has been named to serve as Acting Dean of the School of Science and Technology while Dean Earl E. Lazerson is serving as Acting Vice-President and Provost of the University.

The appointments are subject to ratification by the University Board of Trustees and will be submitted for consideration at the April meeting of the Board.

Chairman of the department of physics since July, 1974, Walford has been a member of the faculty since 1963. He was promoted to the rank of professor in July, 1972 and currently is serving as president of the University Senate.

Walford is a native of Wales and was associated with the Cavendish Laboratory at Cambridge, England before joining the SIUE faculty. He is a graduate of the University of Wales, where he received the bachelor of science degree in physics and mathematics. He completed work for the doctorate in physics at the University of Cambridge.

Walford and his wife, Linda, are residents of St. Louis.
