SUBJECT: Annual Report on Administrative Goal Performance

As I noted, the document appraising our performance measured against the goals set by myself, the Vice-Presidents, and the constituency heads, which was forwarded to you on September 13, would be subjected to appropriate review and revision. After careful scrutiny, it is my opinion that the attached statement properly articulates our assessment.

In forwarding this statement to you, let me reiterate my conviction that whatever successes we have been able to point--and a number of them were significant--depended upon the professional commitment and active cooperation of the entire University community at SIU-E.
