

On Thursday, May 24, Guenther will read from his poetry and translations at 1:30 p.m. in Peck Building Room 0304. Friday evening, May 25, at 7:30 p.m. he will give a lecture entitled "Creative Translation." It will be in the Lovejoy Library Auditorium.

This will be an excellent chance for the University community to become well acquainted with the vast scope of Mr. Guenther's interests and talents. He is conversant with modern and contemporary literature in Western Europe, well known nationally for his translations and his own poetry, and a major inspiration to artists in this region.

After the lecture Friday evening, there will be a reception for Mr. Guenther in the Faculty Club. All members of the University community are cordially invited to attend and meet Mr. Guenther personally.
