SUBJECT: SIUE Charitable Fund Drive - State Employee and Universities  
Combined Appeal

For a number of years, the members of the University faculty and staff have participated in an annual charitable fund drive which provides money and services to citizens in need. This year the State Employee and Universities Combined Appeal (SECA) enables University employees to donate to eight charitable organizations: Black United Fund of Illinois, Combined Health Appeal, Illinois Women's Funding Federation, International Service Agencies, Little City Foundation for Retarded Children, United Negro College Fund, United Way, and the Veterans Protective League.

The 1990 SIUE Charitable Fund Drive - SECA will be conducted from November 14 through December 3. Fund Drive materials will be distributed to each employee by solicitors in the various units.

Last year University employees contributed more than \$40,000 to the joint campaign, a figure that represented the largest University donation to such a campaign. I urge your participation in this year's drive. Your continued concern and generosity will be greatly appreciated by all those who benefit from the work of these eight organizations.
