SUBJECT: Child Care Needs Assessment—Employee Telephone Survey

The SIUE Early Childhood Center (ECC) is currently undergoing a strategic planning process to determine the long-term direction of the unit and the future of child care services at SIUE. To assist in this process, information is needed on specific child care needs and issues facing SIUE employees and students. An Early Childhood Strategic Planning Committee has developed two questionnaires to be administered to SIUE employees and students during the next several weeks.
