

The 1998-99 academic year marks the 50th anniversary of the inauguration of Delyte Morris as president of Southern Illinois University. In his 22 years at SIU, Morris built upon a rich, early history of an institution located in one of the poorest and most rural regions of Illinois. With the establishment of the Edwardsville campus, Morris also oversaw the expansion of the University into the second most populous region of Illinois.
